STOP AND PRAY

Holy Spirit, open my heart and my mind to Your truth today! Then help me to be a Doer of the Word and not a Hearer only!

- 1) What is the image Pastor Allan used to begin the sermon? How does that help us understand the way the Holy Spirit works in our lives?

Read Acts 2:42-47

- 2) What does it mean for someone to be “devoted” to something (v. 42, 46)?

- 3) A) What were the different areas in which the Holy Spirit produced devotion within the people of God?

B) Why do we need the Holy Spirit to cultivate this devotion in us? What happens if I try to devote myself to these things without the Holy Spirit?

4) A) What does it mean for us to be devoted to fellowship? What is the difference between fellowship and socializing?

B) How does our generosity connect with the fellowship that takes place within the church?

5) What happened when the world saw the early church living with this type of devotion (v. 47)?

6) Look back to question 3. What is one area you can pray to see the Holy Spirit cultivate more devotion in your life, even this week? How can we, as a Small Group, support one another in this?

Take time to pray for each other.

Use this prayer as the theme of your prayer time: "*Father in Heaven, thank you for the amazing news of our Spirit-led community. You have given us this group of people that we might grow in our walk with you. May I never think I can do this Christian walk on my own. God help us as a church be a people fully devoted to you so that others might see and know you.*"
