Acts 4:23-37 – 11/05/23

## STOP AND PRAY

*Holy Spirit, open my heart and my mind to Your truth today! Then help me to be a Doer of the Word and not a Hearer only!*

- 1) Share about a time in your life that you felt inadequate or insufficient? Have you ever felt that way about joining in on God's work?

Read Acts 4:22–26

- 2) What did the early church note about God and the opposition that came against Him? (vv. 24–26) How can this help us when we face obstacles?

- 3) Why do you think the Church went to the Psalms to pray to God?

Read Acts 4:27–31

- 4) How did the people see that this Psalm fulfilled in their lives and their day? How can we faithfully apply Scriptures to our lives?
- 5) What was the result of their prayer? How does this encourage you in your prayer life?

Read Acts 4:32–37

- 6) What was the sign that the Holy Spirit's power was on all the people, not just the apostles? (vv. 33–35)
- 7) What are some areas you need the boldness that the early Church prayed for? What are some ways we as a small group can spur one another on to rely on God and join in on His work around us?

*Take time to pray for each other.*

Use this prayer as the theme of your prayer time: *"Father in Heaven, I want to join in on what you are doing in my life, and in our Church. I need your help to live boldly. Help me to live selflessly, and trust in your care. Thank you for providing for us, and would you continue to invite us to join in your kingdom work!"*
