STOP AND PRAY

1) What is something that you are thankful for during this last year?

Read Acts 2:13-21

2) What about Jesus' life, death, and resurrection had such a massive impact on this world?

b) If Jesus' life, death, and resurrection were so impactful to the world, how impactful has this news been in your life? Can you talk about different ways this news has impacted your day-to-day life?

3) What does Peter's quotation of Joel teach us about the current days that we live in?

b) If this information is true, how is it reflected in the way we live our day-to-day lives?

Read Acts 2:22-41

4) Why would Peter claim that this crowd killed Jesus when many of them might not have been a part of the crucifixion?

b) What does this teach us about our role in Jesus' death? What type of response does this produce in your heart?

5) What was the response that Peter called those listening to follow?

b) How does your response to following Jesus correlate to the response Peter called those people listening to his sermon?

c) How does Peter's sermon help us understand how we might share the gospel with those in our lives?

Use this prayer as the theme of your prayer time: *"Father in Heaven, thank you for the amazing news of the gospel. Thank you that my sins against you can be forgiven. May I never forget that my sins placed Jesus on the cross. God help us as a church share this news with those you have placed in our lives. "*
